3. Name and phone number of responsible party for the vehicle

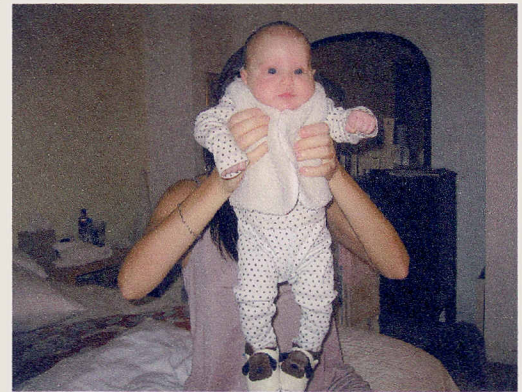
